

HOW TO ORDER COPIES

- ❖ Copies can always be obtained by visiting the archives at a cost of 25¢ per page (letter and legal), ledger-size copies are 50¢ per page.

If you would like a copy of a record or document sent to you, either by mail or email, **first contact our office (by email or phone)**. There is a minimum fee of \$10, which includes up to ten pages of copies, letter or legal size. Because the number of pages vary from record to record, the cost will vary.
